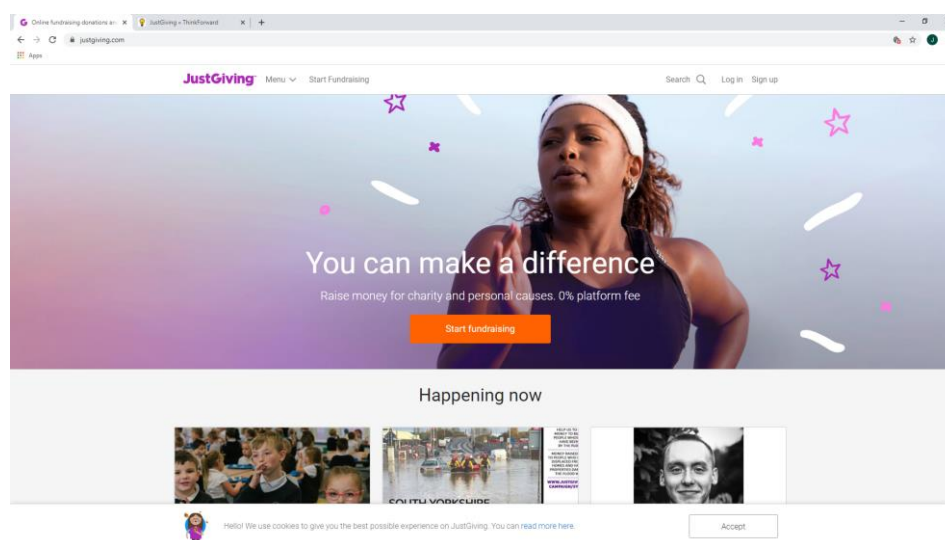

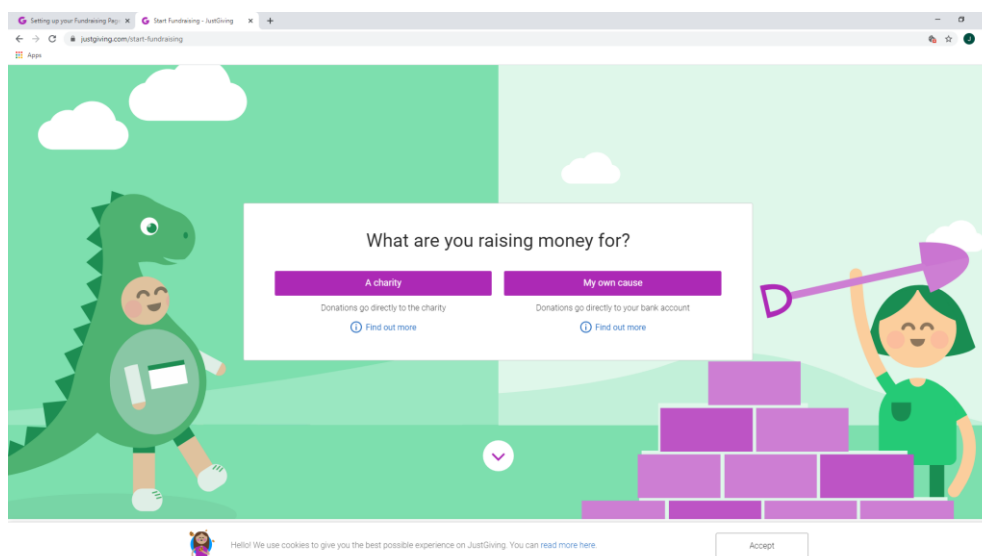
How to set up a JustGiving page

You can set up your own page to fundraise for Rainbow Living at <https://www.justgiving.com/>. Here's how to create your own page.

Click on **'Start fundraising'** on the JustGiving homepage.

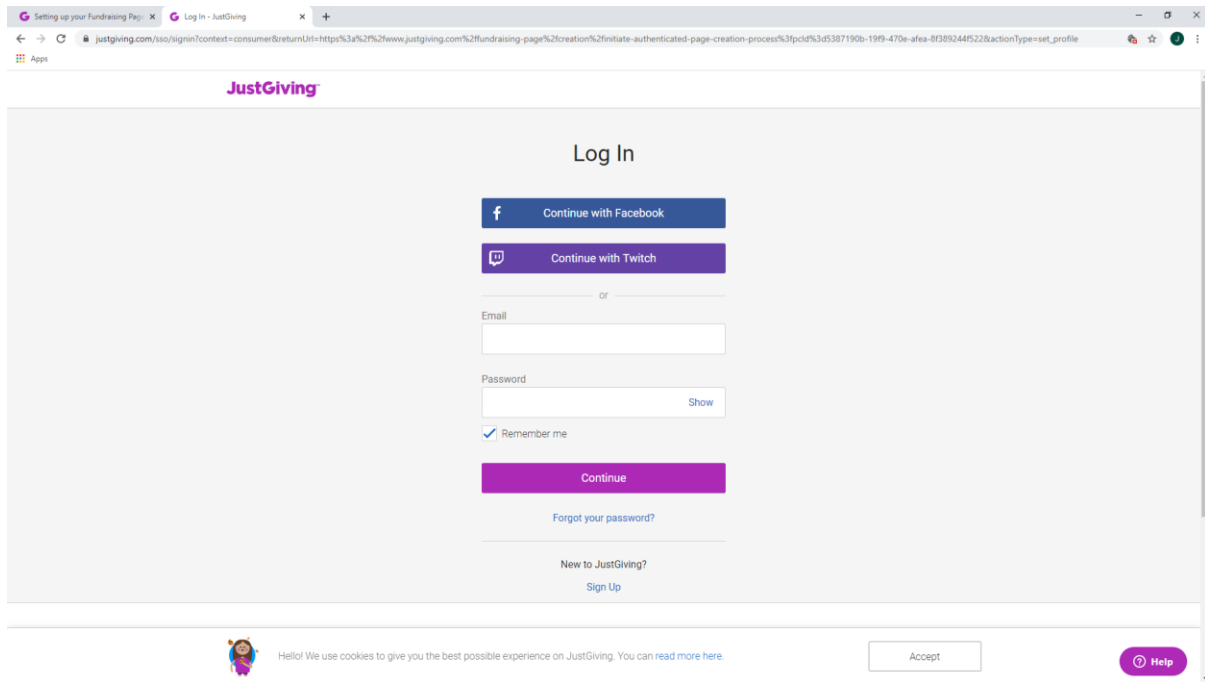


Select the **'Start fundraising' for A Charity**

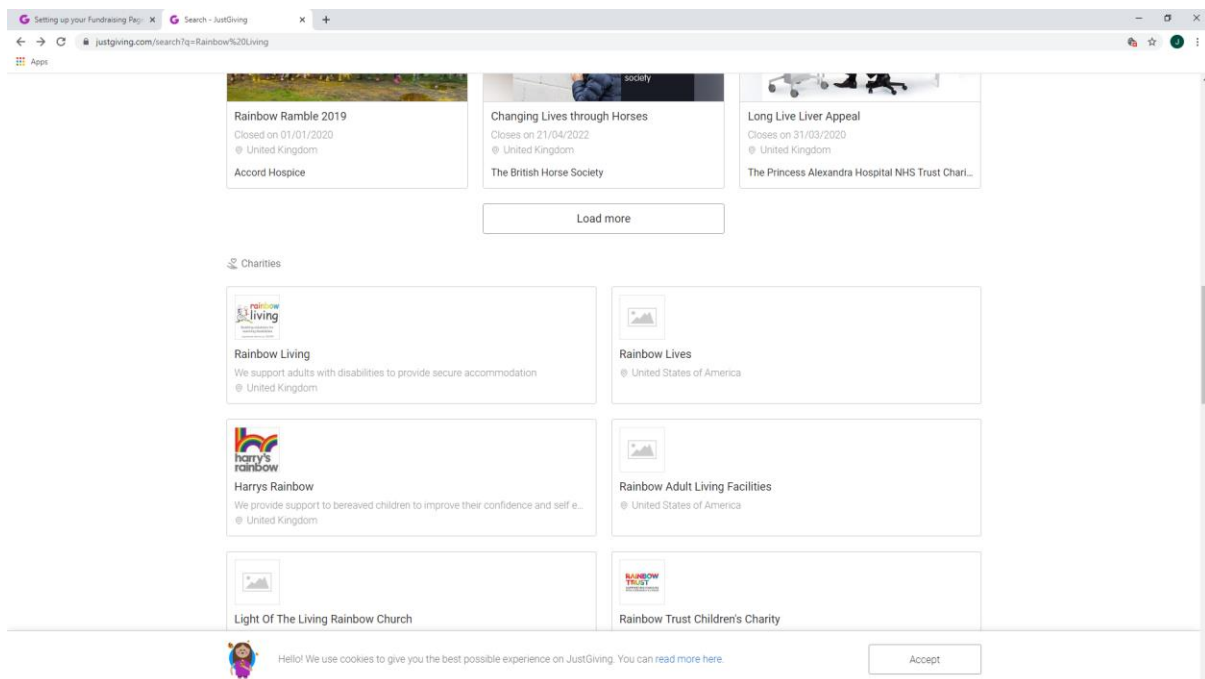


Log in to your JustGiving account.

If you don't already have an account, click **Sign Up** and then enter the required details (your email, name, and create a password) and then Sign Up.




Search for and then select Rainbow Living.



Select what you're doing to raise money: taking part in an organised event, celebrating a personal occasion, raising money in memory of someone, or doing your own thing?

Select or search for your event (this step is only for creating a page for an Organised event).

Finalise your selection. Let JustGiving know if you're doing an event or challenge in memory of someone, if the charity is contributing to the cost of your fundraising, and if you'd like to stay up-to-date with your charity's news and JustGiving's news.

You can also write a thank you message which is automatically sent to your sponsors.
